Overview of HOA dues spending for 2013 and 2014.

1. Took out and replaced where we could over 30 trees. The newly planted trees have a less invasive root system that will not damage side walks and roads.
2. We hired a new landscape company to maintain the common areas and so far are very pleased with the results.
3. Cleaned both detention ponds at the bottom of 204 th of samplings and other growth to bring them up to county specs. In addition to the pond maintenance we had an overgrowth of blackberry bushes removed and treated with weed control and covered with a layer of beauty bark. Par Four landscape Co, is going maintain on a schedule to prevent a costly clean up in the future,
4. We also updated the Red Hawk entrance with some new vegetation along with a design update. In addition we are going to do a better job to maintain the Red Hawk mid entrance.

NOTE: With the replanting of 30 plus trees and a hot summer coming, please keep in mind newly planted trees have to be watered or they will die. The cost of removing and replacing is very costly and we and you want to avoid having to replant because of neglect.

Special thank you to Bonnie and Carl Larsen for planting new summer flowers to help make our entrance even more beautiful.
